The Floodwood School freefalls to bottom 17% of all Schools in the U.S.

Floodwood School gets an F for its Secondary and D for the Elementary (2014-2015)

[Note: this reflects the school for 2014-15 and not the current administration]

The website <u>www.greatschools.org</u> shows a flunking score for Floodwood Secondary Students. In its summary, it shows that SchoolGrades.org gives it an F grade. "SchoolGrades.org uses an international standard of excellence to grade how well America's schools prepare students in core subjects. 17 percent of American schools receive a grade of F, while 83 percent receive a higher grade."

Core rating: Floodwood is in the bottom 17% of American schools.

The Floodwood Secondary, grade range 7-12, has a total enrollment of 139 with 45% getting free/reduced lunch, a <u>national</u> proficiency rate of 14%, and state proficiency rate of 18%.

With one being the lowest ranking, Floodwood received a <u>two out of 10</u> by GreatSchools.

"To calculate our grades [GreatSchools], we begin by looking at the percentage of students in the school who qualify as proficient on state math and reading exams. We then follow a three-step process.

Step 1: Apply a Rigorous National Standard

We adjust the percentage of students who qualify as proficient on the state exams to align with a rigorous national standard.

Step 2: Adjust for Students' Economic Profile

We then account for the percentage of students in the school who are economically disadvantaged.

Step 3: Assign the Final Letter Grade

Finally, we assign a letter grade based on how the school performs relative to international performance benchmarks."

The SchoolGrades numeric score found that if the Floodwood Secondary served the average American student population, just <u>13%</u> of students would meet rigorous national standards in reading and math.

Grade Range Methodology

We [SchoolGrades] begin by looking at the percentage of students who earn scores that qualify as proficient on state math and reading exams. We average the proficiency rates in these two subjects to get the school's overall state proficiency percentage.

Given that it's often easier to earn a proficient score on a state exam than on a leading national exam (i.e., NAEP), we then determine the percentage of students who meet the more rigorous national standard. This allows us to compare how the school's students are doing relative to their peers across the country.

School Proficiency Percentages Under State and National Standard [for Floodwood Secondary]

Math: 15% (out of 100)

Reading: 20% (out of 100)

Overall State Proficiency: 18% (out of 100)

National Proficiency: 14% (out of 100)

While 66 percent of students in Minnesota qualify as proficient under the state's own standard, 44 percent of the state's students qualify as proficient under rigorous national standard (i.e., NAEP). We use this difference to apply the rigorous national standard to the school's test results.

We then take into account the percentage of students who qualify for the federal government's free and reduced price lunch program. This adjustment gives extra credit to schools that serve economically disadvantaged students and holds schools that serve affluent students to a higher standard.

The last step in our process is to assign final letter grades - A, B, C, D, F- based on how the school would rank internationally in comparison to the performance of students in more than 60 countries on the Program for International Student Assessment (PISA)

FLOODWOOD SECONDARY's overall adjusted proficiency rate of 13 percent earns it a grade of F. The school's **performance is similar to the average performance of schools in Chile, Serbia and Thailand. Seventeen (17%) of American schools receive a grade of F**, while 83 percent receive a higher grade.

You saw the Floodwood Forum limit their evaluation to the regions schools. This is a much broader measurement showing all residents exactly how far their school has plummeted. Every year they are told that the board and administration are implementing new systems moving forward, but forward progress is clearly not being shown in recent years. None of us need a political, feel good message to erase the facts and be left with hope for the future. The board and administration follow the same beaten trail leading to mediocrity, and in this case far, far worse. If you can't accept the dire facts, how can you forge a real plan for improvement?

CROMWELL-WRIGHT SECONDARY's overall adjusted proficiency rate of 41 percent earns it a grade of B. The school's performance is similar to the average performance of schools in Canada, Japan, and Australia. 19 percent of American schools receive a grade of B, while 23 percent receive a higher grade.

This shows two schools of nearly equal conditions (size, location, and free/reduced lunches) achieving quite different results. It's time to start looking at the people carrying out the programs, because like diet plans, they all work, when people adhere to the plan.
